The importance of real estate investing to the American economy rivals that of the stock market; the value of U.S. income-producing real estate is in the multi trillions of dollars. 11 measured over the past quarter century, real estate has provided lower returns, but at lower risk, than has a diversified portfolio of corporate common stock.
