1. Please translate the following news paragraphs into Chinese.

US Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice said today that she appealed to Chinese leaders to find a way to ease tensions with Taiwan, saying that the mainland's anti-secession law aimed at the self-ruled island has aggravated the situation. "Clearly the anti-secession law did increase tensions," Rice said at a news conference after meeting President Hu Jintao and other Chinese leaders. Rice said she told Chinese leaders that "the most useful path would be to find ways to reduce tensions". Rice didn't give any details of possible steps that she might have suggested to the Chinese. But she repeated Washington's criticism that the law was "not helpful" in maintaining regional peace and stability.

Opinion polls in Taiwan show most people do not believe an unemployed man shot President Chen Shui-bian in a bizarre election-eve attack last year, even though police call him their top suspect, reports said on Wednesday. Police say Chen Yihsiung, who committed suicide by drowning 9 days after the March 19 attack, is most likely the would-be assassin who fired a handmade gun at Chen and grazed him across the stomach. Vice President Annette Lu was also injured in the attack, which opposition parties suspect to have been staged for sympathy votes. Chen and Lu won re-election by a razor-thin 0.2 percent margin on March 20. A survey of 735 people by the mass-circulation China Times newspaper found 51 percent had doubts over the police account, compared with 26 percent who said they believed it.
